3. **SETTING:** Describe the setting of the book in 2 – 5 sentences. (10 pts.)
4. **DICTIONARY:** Select five (5) words that you either don't know at all, or you do not know very well. Write the definition of these words and use them in a sentence. (20 pts.)
5. **ILLUSTRATION:** Illustrate a chapter of the book. Include color, a background, the title or number of the chapter, and a three sentence summary of the chapter. (25 pts.)
