



## **National Junior Honor Society Qualifications:**

### **Scholarship**

- Maintains a 92 general average on each report card. Must have 90 and above in all grades.
- Maintains 3 or above in behavior and effort on each report card.

### **Leadership**

- Has a positive attitude
- Demonstrates positive behavior
- Is dependable and reliable
- Has a positive influence on peers in upholding ideals and spirit
- Demonstrate initiative in promoting school activities
- Has performed service to the school in a specific way (elected as an officer for student council, a leadership position on a sports team, or scouting activity, a team captain, peer mediation leader, etc.)

### **Service**

- Continuously participated in some activity outside of school; for example, Religious services (cantor, altar server, or choir, volunteer services for the sick, the poor, the elderly, and the disadvantaged. (taking flowers to the shut-ins, Aid for Friends, Scout community service projects)
- Show courtesy by assisting visitors, teachers, and students.
- Works well with others and is willing to take on difficult or inconspicuous responsibilities (acts as a mentor to another student needing help, befriends a new student and helps guide them in how the school works, etc.)
- Cheerfully and enthusiastically renders any requested service to the school (helps over the summer with tasks in the school, stays afterschool to help with projects, etc.)
- Volunteers and provides dependable and well-organized assistance, is happy and willing to sacrifice to offer assistance to someone.

### **Character**

- Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior (e.g. cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, stability)
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability.
- Regularly shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others.
- Observes instructions and rules both inside and outside the classroom.
- Manifests truthfulness in acknowledging obedience to rules, avoiding cheating, and showing an unwillingness to profit by the mistakes of others.

## **Citizenship**

- Has a high regard for freedom and justice and respects the laws of the School, local community, and the state.
- Demonstrates mature participation and responsibility through involvement with such activities as scouting, community organizations, and school clubs.
